

Uganda Cities Map

Learning Guide: The Uganda Cities Map is meant for educational use with blind and low vision students. The map teaches the locations of major Uganda cities. The kit can also be used to study Uganda's lakes, rivers, cities, landmarks, and borders.

Description: The Uganda Cities Map is a 3D printed plate that uses raised lines to outline the border of the country and raised circles to highlight major cities. On the top left corner of the plate is a compass to establish cardinal directions, a scale to demonstrate sizing, and a small outline of Africa with a mark inside showing where Uganda is. There are braille labels throughout the map naming cities, rivers, lakes, bordering countries, and more. Because these labels are abbreviated, a key is also included to define what each label stands for. You will also find raised dotted lines following the major rivers that run through Uganda, as well as lowered dotted sections to represent larger bodies of water like Lakes Victoria, Albert, and Kyoga. Perfect for educational purposes and providing an engaging and accessible learning experience for blind and low vision students.
