

Uganda Elevations Map

Learning Guide: The Uganda Elevations Map is meant for educational use with blind and low vision students. The map teaches various aspects of Uganda's geography. The kit can be used to study Uganda's mountains, lakes, rivers, cities, landmarks, and borders.

Description: The Uganda Elevations Map is a 3D printed plate that demonstrates the geographical elevations of Uganda via raises and depressions on the surface. On the top left corner of the plate is a compass to establish cardinal directions, a scale to demonstrate sizing, and a small outline of Africa with a mark inside showing where Uganda is. There are braille labels throughout the map naming cities, rivers, lakes, bordering countries, and more. Because these labels are abbreviated, a key is also included to define what each label stands for. You will also find raised dotted lines following the major rivers that run through Uganda, as well as lowered dotted sections to represent larger bodies of water like Lakes Victoria, Albert, and Kyoga. Perfect for educational purposes and providing an engaging and accessible learning experience for blind and low vision students.

Solid lines: country borderlines

Dashed line: the equator

Dotted lines: rivers

Lowered dotted sections: lakes

Raised circles (with braille abbreviations): cities

Raised rectangles (with braille abbreviations): landmarks, bodies of water, and neighboring countries
